PRS40103 Certificate IV in Security and Risk Management

Participants are placed in the role of a security manager for virtual staff and clients in a virtual company, a simulated security and risk management business. This strategy bases Participants learning on authentic scenarios from the following industry areas:

- Close personal protection
- Cash in transit
- Special events
- Control room operations
- Security risk consulting
- Investigations
- Security management


Additionally team topics are available for each unit of competency. Participants are able to practice working with a group and discussing issues with other participants. This gives a chance for participants to learn communication skills such as consulting, sharing ideas and considering other points of view, which are paramount to a security risk manager's role.

Apart from working towards a nationally recognised qualification, Participants will be increasing their skills and knowledge in the security industry as a whole.

As the principles across the industry are similar, participants will be able to take what they have learnt from one industry area and apply this to other areas.

Assessment Strategy

To achieve this qualification the candidate must have demonstrated competency against all 11 core units plus 4 elective units. Up to two of the required four electives may be selected from other relevant endorsed Training Package qualifications aligned at the Certificate IV level.



Each unit has a series of tasks for participants to complete. These tasks are based on participants solving possible real life problems that occur as part of working in the security industry. Participants leave this course with a professional portfolio of assessed works to act as a professional resource guide.

Flexible Learning and Assessment

The strategy incorporates a blended learning. This is a combination of multiple approaches to learning using virtual and physical resources such as the technology based online toolbox, face-to-face sessions and practical delivery. This enables participants to follow a learning path of their choice whether they choose to read material and then complete the activity sheets or vice versa.

All courses are professionally facilitated including practical application of skills in an engaging forum. All participants receive a workbook to complement the learning of the program and to retain as a reference source. Specialist courses often include specialist equipment packs on successful completion of the course.

Qualification of this course is achieved through a demonstrated understanding of broad knowledge base, theoretical concepts. Apply solutions to a defined range of unpredictable problems. Identify and apply skill and knowledge areas to a wide variety of contexts. Identify, analyse and evaluate information from a variety of sources. Take responsibility for their own outputs in relation to specified quality standards.
